



PRM Training | Chief / Deputy Chief Warden Training

This training will educate Chief & Deputy Chief Wardens or Incident Controllers to adequately manage their workplace when experiencing an emergency onsite. This course will focus on how to adequately prevent, prepare, respond, and recover from potential workplace emergencies. This training will delve into the associated risks and hazards of emergency response and containment, and most importantly educate the Chief Warden as to which workplace emergencies are not suitable to respond to and render safe. This training will focus on how Chief Wardens can best integrate with responding emergency services.

This training is based upon AS 3745- Planning for emergencies in facilities, relevant workplace health & safety regulations and industry best practice.

Topics Discussed

- Development and maintenance of the emergency plan
- Emergency Organisation roles and responsibilities
- Developing incident control strategies, command presence and maintaining control during emergencies
- Induction of new staff members, and exposure to emergency procedures
- Responding to alarms & emergencies, including competent use of installed systems
- Building performance during emergencies including installed building systems such as HVAC, security or air management
- Interacting with fire detection and suppression systems
- Isolating fire systems and the chain of responsibility
- Effective and competent communication during an emergency
- Use of installed emergency communications equipment
- Defining the role of emergency services, and how to integrate responses
- Assisting occupants with mobility impairment (Including Personal Emergency Evacuation Plans)

Class Size / 20 maximum

Duration / 3 hours in conjunction with Warden (ECO) training or 6 hours stand-alone

Style

In class seminar, with demonstrations and discussions, including slides and video. This is a seminar-based training with limited hands-on exercises. Additional class participation is encouraged through discussions, questions and answers.

This training is recommended for anyone who is or may act in the role of Chief or Deputy Chief Warden, floor or area manager, unit manager, or facility supervisor.
