



Emergency Safety and Tactical Fire Plans (ESIP and TFP)

An Emergency Safety and Incident Plan (ESIP) and Tactical Fire Plan (TFP) are required for any facility that currently has, or is anticipated to have, a manifest quantity of hazardous chemicals as outlined in the [WHS Regulations of New South Wales](#). Additionally, an ESIP is mandatory for facilities with a fire control room where fire engineering plays a critical role in the detection and suppression of fires or hazardous material incidents.

The ESIP and TFP serve as an evolution of the Emergency Management Plan (EMP), ensuring seamless coordination from emergency response to post-incident recovery. PRM ensures alignment between the EMP, ESIP, and potentially the Business Continuity Plan, ensuring all plans are unified in their objectives and strategies. This includes a clear transition from the initial emergency response to handover to Fire and Rescue NSW (FRNSW), followed by business impact assessments and continuity activities once the site is handed back to the client.

In our approach, we analyse a facility from a tactical perspective, considering factors such as:

- Fire detection and suppression systems
- Fuel load, type, and quantity of hazardous chemicals
- Engineered features designed to contain or mitigate potential emergencies
- The functions of the business and the capability of staff to prevent, prepare for, and respond to likely emergencies

PRM will develop a plan that evolves the site's EMP, enhancing the ability of fire services to tactically use the facility's features to manage fires or hazardous materials incidents. This approach enables both offensive and defensive strategies. The ESIP also includes Tactical Fire Plan maps, which can be used at any time—day or night—by responding fire services. These maps are designed to provide crucial information using language familiar to fire services, with a focus on firefighter safety.
